School Program Fact Sheet

Schools will be financially responsible for equipment rentals, lift tickets and lessons. Individual participant payments cannot be processed by Mt. Dufour. Group payments must be made to Mt. Dufour Ski Area Inc.

As we are a nonprofit facility, mainly open weekdays for the snow school program a cancellation on the schools part will incur a fee if we are unable to fill the date of your booking. Once you have confirmed your date you are responsible to fulfill that commitment. We will make every effort to re-schedule or a refund will be made in the event of area closure due to extreme weather or facility breakdown.

Reservations for equipment rentals, including rental forms and signed waivers MUST be received ONE WEEK PRIOR to your booking date. This allows us to be prepared for you when you arrive, and gets you out on the hill sooner. It also allows us to ensure we have all the necessary equipment you require.

Rental contracts must be filled out and signed by the parent/guardian. Lost or damaged equipment, due to misuse, is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Schools are required to provide adequate supervision for their students AT ALL TIMES during their visit to Mt. Dufour. One School staff member/chaperone will be designated as the main contact for Mt. Dufour Staff. THIS MEANS one chaperone remains in the chalet and a ratio of 1 chaperone for every 10 students is required ON THE HILL ! Chaperones skiing or snowboarding who do not require lessons or equipment will be charged a rate of \$20 for the day.

Chairlift use is restricted to those participants that demonstrate the skills required to use the lift, and navigate the larger hills. Snow School Instructors will determine a participants readiness; otherwise the participant is restricted to the Beginner's lift and Area.

All participants are required to abide by the Alpine Responsibility Code, and the rules and regulations of Mt. Dufour Ski Area Inc. All participating students MUST watch the Mandatory Video in class prior to arrival at Mt. Dufour. The video will be provided by Mt. Dufour Snow School (one copy per school) and is thereafter the responsibility of the school. If you are new to us this year please call ASAP and we will send you your free copy.

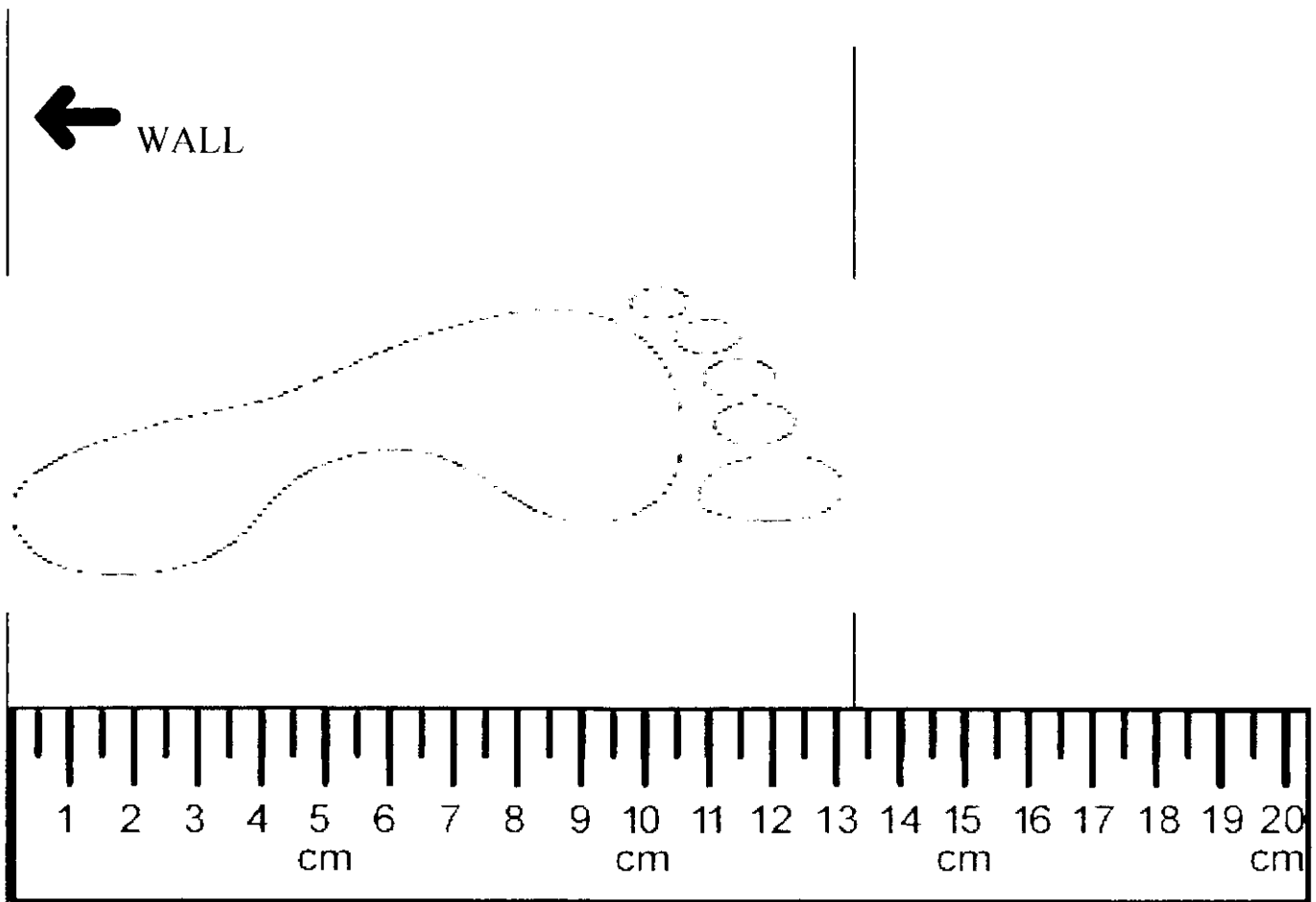

***Teachers please do this in class to be sure it is done properly.
Improper boot sizes makes for long wait times at the rental shop!

1. PLACE A RULER AGAINST THE WALL
2. PLACE YOUR HEEL AGAINST THE WALL
3. MEASURE "IN CENTIMETERS" TO THE LONGEST TO POINT.

I accept for use as is the equipment listed on this form, and accept full financial responsibility for the care of the equipment while it is in my possession. I will be responsible for the replacement at full value of any equipment rented under this form, but not returned to the rental facility. I agree to return all rental equipment by the agreed date.

I understand that the binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety. In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding, cross-country skiing, skiboarding, snowshoeing and other sports utilizing equipment with non-release bindings, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use, these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I understand that the sports of skiing, snowboarding, skiboarding, snowshoeing and other sports (collectively "RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS") involve inherent and other risks of INJURY and DEATH. I voluntarily agree to expressly assume all risks of injury or death that may result from these RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS, or which relate in any way to the use of this equipment. I understand that a helmet designed for RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS use will help reduce the risk of some types of injuries to the user at slower speeds. I recognize that serious injury or death can result from both low and high energy impacts, even when a helmet is worn.

I AGREE TO RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the equipment rental facility, its employees, owners, affiliates, agents, officers, directors, and the equipment manufactures and distributors and their successors in interest (collectively "PROVIDERS"), from all liability for injury, death, property loss and damage which results from the equipment user's participation in the RECREATIONAL SNOW SPORTS for which the equipment is provided, or which is related in any way to the use of this equipment, including all liability which results from the NEGLIGENCE of PROVIDERS, or any other person or cause.

I further agree to defend and indemnify PROVIDERS for any loss or damage, including any that results from claims or lawsuits for personal injury, death and property loss and damage related in any way to the use of this equipment.

This agreement is governed by the applicable law of this state or province. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other provisions shall be given full force and effect.

2. Schedule Chaperones and supervisors for your visit. ***Remember for safety reasons 1 Adult Chaperone is required “on the hill” for every 10 students, and one is required in the chalet as well.

3. Have teachers complete the “Student Information Sheet” (see attached pg 4) Include all Chaperones.

***It is very important that the foot length for rentals is measured as requested in centimeters (see attached pg 6). Shoe sizes and ski boot /snowboard boot sizes ARE NOT the same. It is also very important that ability levels are filled out accurately. To set up Snowboards we need to know which foot goes forward, those who ride right foot forward are called goofy, left foot forward are called regular. For these reasons we are asking that the teachers do the measurements in class and fill in this form accurately.

“B” Beginners-- students have never skied/snowboarded before. Or only a few times on the Bunny hill.

“I” Intermediate--skiers have the ability to hold a snowplow, stop and turn on demand
---snowboarders have the ability to use both heel and toe edges and can stop on demand

“A”-advanced--skiers have the ability to ski in parallel

---snowboarders have the ability to link turns (from edge to edge), turn on demand

4. Send waiver forms home to be signed by parent/guardian. Signed waiver forms MUST be at the hill before the students will be permitted to participate.

5. Fill in “Snow School Tally Sheet” Include ALL participants, students and chaperones as well. (see attached pg 5)
